

## English for football – week 20

### Last gasp goal

Today's English for football is a last gasp winner or last gasp equalizer. Now last gasp in football means at the last moment, in the last minute, so for example, the 90<sup>th</sup> minute or in extra time. A last gasp winner is a goal scored in the 90<sup>th</sup> minute or extra time. For example John O'Shea's goal against Liverpool was a last gasp winner beating the Reds one-nil at Anfield. A last gasp equaliser: for example, Messi scored a last gasp equaliser for Barcelona against real Madrid. His goal meant that Barcelona drew with real Madrid 3-3 in the 90<sup>th</sup> minute.
