And all that despite a crisis in his career in 1998 when he performed below par at the World Cup and was clearly mentally not ready for the final where he was a huge disappointment. The next year he injured his right knee badly and it was to be nearly two years before he fully recovered. But he did recover and stormed back onto the World stage outshining David Beckham in the World Cup in Korea and Japan. However, this latest injury, a ruptured tendon in his left knee, has many commentators wondering if he can make a come back. he had seemed set to regain some of his past sharpness partnering Pato up front for AC Milan, and at 31, age is on his side, but you have to wonder if the hunger will still be there for a player who was already been on the Brazilian team bench in a world cup at 17.

It would be a sad way to hang up his 9 shirt, but if he doesn't come back, he will be remembered as one of the greatest strikers... ever.
