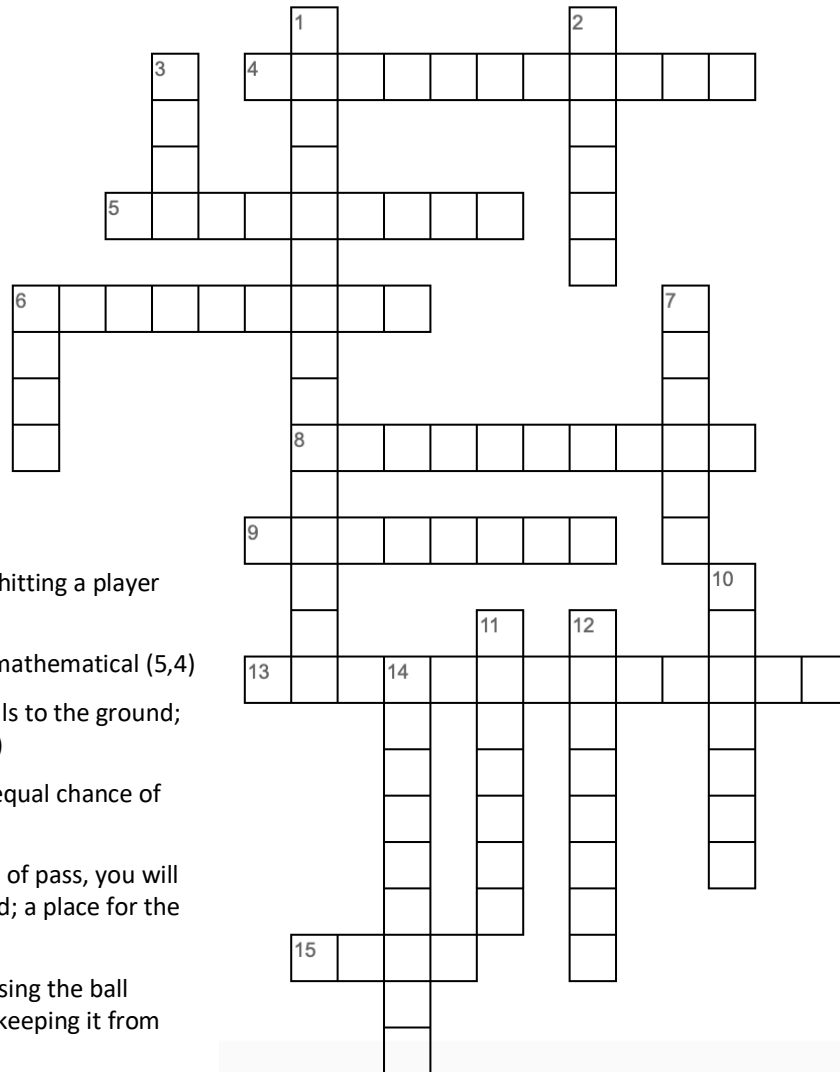


Learn English through Football Worksheet:

- 4 tackled by sliding and hitting a player before the ball (4,7)
- 5 a very accurate pass; mathematical (5,4)
- 6 tackle so the player falls to the ground; make depressed? (5,4)
- 8 both players have an equal chance of getting the ball (5,5)
- 9 if you receive this kind of pass, you will be immediately tackled; a place for the injured
- 13 describes a team passing the ball among many players, keeping it from the other team (5,2,5)
- 15 a type of pass that raises the ball slightly; a quick strike or hit

Down

- 1 when you deliberately foul or injure someone (5,4,4,2)
- 2 a pass given without looking (2,4)
- 3 a tackle resulting in a free kick; bad chicken
- 6 a great ___ into the box; it's round
- 7 two quick passes between two players; counting (3,3)
- 10 a red card tackle; part of the boot (5,2)
- 11 find a player with a pass; usually a difficult, accurate pass (4,3)
- 12 the keeper can't pick this up!
- 14 a very hard tackle; sound of snow underfoot?
